Animal Picture Card Day

Animal Picture Day can be 45 minutes to 2 hours, depending on the size of the group

Animal adventure
1 edited picture card per participant
Group poster picture

An animal EDventure where students get to meet, learn about, and interact with up to 7 different species!

1. Bubbles, Blossom & Buttercup the 3 lop bunnies
2. Tortilla the tortoise
3. Gillette & Toupee, the guinea pigs
4. Sugar & Spice, the fancy rats
5. Tank the giant purple land crab
6. Biggie, aka Mr Cowboy the giant African bullfrog
7. Cupcake the tarantula
8. Spooky, the tiny California kingsnake
9. Ghost the albino cornsnake
10. Mushu the red iguana
11. Pixie the pigeon

All activities are 1 hour long,
come with an edited picture per
student & a 2 Critter meet & greet!
Groups of up to 20

1. Climate Change & Future Careers Day – Presentation

Students learn how climate change affects animals and discover careers in both the animal care and the environmental sector to help protect the environment.

2. Pet Day – Craft Activity

An interactive lesson about different types of pets and responsible ownership, followed by sculpting a mini clay pet to take home.

3. Parachute Day – Prize Game

A cooperative parachute game where teams work together to land velcro balls on targets to score points and win prizes.

4. Card-Making Day – Art Creation

Students participate in a self-esteem activity by writing positive messages for classmates, then create a handmade card for someone they care about.

5. Card-Making Day (Holiday or Event Theme) – Art Creation

Students design themed greeting cards using a wide variety of craft and art materials.

6. Piggy Craft Day – Craft Activity

Students learn where foods like milk, eggs, and meat come from and create a fun pig-pen craft using toys, chocolate pudding “mud,” and popsicle stick fencing.

7. Dino Hunt Day – Collaborative Activity

Students search for hidden dinosaur toys in a child-safe sand jungle bin in this hands-on discovery activity.

8. How to Draw Day – Art Creation

Students follow a step-by-step drawing lesson to create a leopard, adding their own decorations and sticker spots.

9. All About Agriculture Day – Collaborative Activity

Students build a farm scene together using a felt board while learning about farm animals and agriculture.

10. Bug Day – Craft Activity

Students build their own bug craft while watching an educational video about insects and how insect colonies work.

11. Watercolor Day – Art Creation

Students learn about wildlife conservation while following guided steps to paint a roaring tiger with watercolor.

12. Aquarium Building Day – Craft Activity

Students learn about oceans and sea creatures before creating their own decorated light-up aquarium craft.

13. Pop'n Catch Day – Prize Game

A relay-style game where students use pop-and-catch paddles to earn points and win small prizes.

14. Make your own Cleaning Solution Day (starting June 2026)

Make your own cleaning spray solution, learn about the science behind cleaning properties, pick between different scents and take it home in a mini spray bottle!

15. Sticky Lizards Game Day – Prize Game

Students throw sticky lizards at jungle targets to score points in this fun coordination game.

16. Slime-Making Day – Craft Activity

Students learn about metamorphosis in animals like frogs and insects before creating and decorating their own slime.

17. Clay Critter Creation Day – Craft Activity

Students learn about evolution and adaptation while sculpting their own imaginative creature from air-dry clay.

18. Build Your Own Bird Glider Day – Craft Activity

Students learn the basics of bird flight before building and decorating a wooden bird glider to fly.

19. Clay Creation Day – Craft Activity

Students create a hand-pressed clay plaque or ornament and decorate it to take home.

20. Dino Fossil Excavation Day – Craft Activity

Students watch an educational dinosaur video and excavate their own fossil using mini paleontology tools.

21. Egg Hatch Prize Surprise Day – Craft Activity

Students learn about eggs and carefully crack open a plaster egg to reveal a hidden prize inside.

22. Reading With Critters Day – Reading Activity

Students read books alongside calm animal companions to build reading confidence and enjoyment.

23. Keychain Decorating Day – Craft Activity

Students decorate wooden keychains using paint and craft materials to create their own keepsake.

24. Hungry Hungry Snakes Game Day – Prize Game

Teams compete in a lively game to collect the most “mice,” earning points and prizes.

25. Our Body & Stress Activity Day – Exercise Lesson

Students learn how stress can affect the body and practice simple exercises that help reduce its impact.

26. Painting Day – Art Creation

Students create their own acrylic painting on canvas alongside their favourite critter.

27. Finger Painting Day – Art Creation

Young students explore colours and textures with toddler-safe finger paints while creating their own artwork.

28. Sensory Exploration Day – Sensory Activity

Students explore a Canadian ecosystem through sensory bins with water, sand, and pond environments.

29. Hay Hunt Day – Sensory Activity

Students search through hay to find toy foods and sort them into the correct food categories.

30. Bug Scavenger Hunt Day – Collaborative Activity

Students use bug nets and catchers to find hidden insects around the room and place them on the correct bug board.

31. Manga Character Creation Day – Art Creation

Students design their own manga-style character using character sheets and professional manga markers.

32. Superhero Character Creation Day – Art Creation

Students create a superhero version of themselves using character sheets and comic-style art supplies.

33. I Love Myself Day – Craft Activity

Students decorate life-size outlines of themselves while writing positive things they love about who they are.

34. Pastel Art Day – Art Creation

Students learn pastel drawing techniques and create a colourful flower field using layered pastel colours.

35. Cooperation Art Workshop Day - Art Creation

Students get to learn about appropriate vs inappropriate cooperation in interpersonal, family, friendship, academic, and professional relationships and how to successfully collaborate and navigate in those situations while we create a self-portrait using your choice of markers or pastels!

36. Design a Canvas Bag Day - Art Creation

Students get to create their own design or use stencils to design and decorate a useful canvas bag using special fabric markers and paints!
